As „violin maker in residence at the SIMA“, internationally acclaimed luthier Stefan-Peter Greiner will be part of the SIMA 2021 for the second time. In his public workshop at the 11th SIMA, he will explain to the question about what a „beautiful sound“ means, and why we do specifically prefer one sound to another.

Furthermore, Greiner will be giving individual consultation to the participants concerning sound adjustments and questions about sound in general.

After a huge success at the SIMA 2019, the participants will again have the opportunity to actively participate in the process of creating a new violin by sawing and carving the wood themselves in Stefan-Peter Greifers workshop.

Stefan-Peter Greiner is among the most successful luthiers of our time. His instruments are being played by soloists such as Christian Tetzlaff, Antje Weithaas, Leonidas Kavakos, Ivry Gitlis as well as in world's leading orchestras - from Berlin to New York - and numerous renowned chamber music ensembles.
