

Firth Rebecca – Violoncello



The cellist Rebecca Firth is a graduate of The Royal Northern College of Music, Manchester, where she studied with Donald Mc Call. Winning several prizes and a Swiss government scholarship, Rebecca continued her studies with Thomas Demenga in Basel and has since had a career playing with major Swiss orchestras (Opera House Zürich, Chamber Orchestra Basel a.o.) and as a highly sought after chamber musician. She is a member of the Aulos Quartet, Zürich.

Her greatest passion lies in the work with young, engaged musicians. Rebecca Firth teaches at the PreCollege of the Zürich Hochschule der Künste (ZHdK) and the Conservatory in Zürich (MKZ) and has been guest teacher at several festivals, such as the Margess International, the Seongnam Music Festival in South Korea and at YOUTH CLASSICS Swiss International Music Academy in Rheinau, Switzerland.

Numerous pupils from Rebecca Firth's class have become prize winners at national and international competitions and have gone on to enjoy extensive careers with orchestras such as the London Symphony Orchestra, the Berlin Philharmonic Orchestra or well-known chambermusic ensembles and as cello teachers in several Swiss Music Schools.
